

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, year end meeting, held at the Twp Hall Jacksontown, OH at 7:00pm on December 27, 2004.

Mr. Cooper called the meeting to order with the following members present: Dave Miller, Ron Acord, Joe Cooper and Jill Linn.

Others present: Richard Cash, Mike Briggs, Steve Patterson and Charlie Davis.

The Trustees signed Certificates of Appreciation and a letter to volunteers in the township.

A discussion took place regarding the townships role in the tree limbs that were cut down because of the ice storm. As of right now, the Trustees decided to leave the tree limbs where they are until they check the policy of the county and state.

Mike Briggs thanked the road crew and trustees for clearing the roads after the storm.

Mr. Cooper mentioned that the City of Heath will be annexing 9 acres of township land. The City of Heath now owns the property. Mr. Cooper will follow up on the situation.

Mr. Cooper asked all departments to think about significant happenings for the 2004 year and asked them to think about goals for 2005.

A discussion took place regarding water a problem on Terry Linn Drive.
